- **GRBS (Glucose Random Blood Sugar)**
- **General Doctor Consultation**

Specialist doctors and medical professionals from **Narayana Hospital, Mysuru**, conducted the screening and consultations. The event was managed with the active support of MSW students and faculty, who helped in registration, patient guidance, and awareness dissemination.

More than **60 individuals** benefited from the camp, including students, faculty, local residents, and non-teaching staff.
