**Purpose and scope of the event:**

**Details of the event:**

The event commenced with the introduction of **Mr. Abhishek Gowda**, *Software Development Engineer at Secuzity*, and **Mr. Gurunath A. K.**, *Certified Ethical Hacker* by Ms. Lakshmitha, Assistant Professor, Department of MCA.

Mr. Abhishek Gowda began the technical session by sharing valuable insights into the **fundamentals of software programming** and demonstrating how to design and develop **responsive websites without coding**. He introduced participants to various user-friendly tools that enable quick website creation and hosting, even for beginners. Additionally, he provided an overview of the **website**

**development process** and highlighted **internship opportunities** in this domain, encouraging students to explore careers in web development and related technologies.

Mr. **Gurunath A. K.** took over the session with an engaging discussion on the **increasing importance of cybersecurity** in today's interconnected digital world. He explained how the rapid growth of technology has also led to a surge in cyber threats, emphasizing the need for individuals and organizations to stay alert and informed. He discussed various **types of cyber threats and vulnerabilities**, such as phishing, ransomware, malware attacks, and social engineering, using **real-life examples of data breaches** to illustrate how hackers exploit system weaknesses and human errors to gain unauthorized access to sensitive information.

In the practical segment, Mr. Gurunath introduced participants to **useful cybersecurity tools and online platforms** that can help identify whether personal or organizational data has been compromised. Through live demonstrations, he showed how these tools work and stressed the importance of **regularly checking digital footprints** to ensure data safety. He concluded by encouraging students to develop strong cybersecurity awareness and adopt safe online practices, highlighting that cybersecurity is not just a technical issue but a shared responsibility in the digital age. He concluded by discussing **internship opportunities in ethical hacking and cybersecurity**, motivating students to pursue these emerging fields and equipping them with knowledge essential for becoming responsible cybersecurity professionals.
